TransAqua announces 2017 compost season opening and hours of operation

RIVERVIEW, N.B. – TransAqua, the Greater Moncton Wastewater Commission, announced today that its 2017 compost sales will begin on Monday, May 1, at its compost facility located at 399 Delong Drive in Moncton.

Extended spring hours – May 1 to June 23, 2017

Monday to Saturday	8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
Sundays and holidays	Closed

Regular summer and fall hours - June 26 to October 27, 2017

Monday to Friday	8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
Weekends and holidays	Closed

The public is advised that the compost site will be closed on the following holidays: Victoria Day (Monday, May 22); Canada Day (Monday, July 3); New Brunswick Day (Monday, Aug. 7); Labour Day (Monday, Sept. 4); and Thanksgiving (Monday, Oct. 9). The compost facility will close for the season to the public on Friday, Oct. 27, at 4 p.m.

Free compost is available to residents of Moncton, Dieppe and Riverview who wish to self-load compost into their own vehicles/containers. Should residents prefer not to self-load, TransAqua staff will load vehicles (i.e. non-commercial trailer and/or pickup-type truck) for a flat fee of \$5 per bucket full (small tractor).

The compost loading fee will be waived for members of the Canadian military and veterans, as well as current and retired members of the RCMP. (Proper ID must be shown.) This is a token of our thanks and support for those who keep our community and country safe every day. Our compost is designated as type A or AA by BNQ (Bureau de Normalisation du Québec) or Category A by CQA –managed by Compost Council of Canada, which are the highest compost certifiable quality standards achievable in Canada. We are happy to give back to the community. We're looking forward to being part of Greater Moncton's gardens and landscapes again this year.

TransAqua, the Greater Moncton Wastewater Commission, (www.transaqua.ca) was established in 1983 to support the wastewater collection and treatment needs of the Dieppe, Moncton and Riverview tri-community. Since then, it has developed a 31 kilometre collection network and a treatment facility to best deliver on this mandate. It has also become a leader in the reuse of biosolids through the generation of high quality compost as opposed to disposal in a landfill site. TransAqua is beginning its WWTF Upgrade and Modernization Project in 2017 to provide an enhanced secondary treatment approach that will allow it to meet the mandatory federal regulations prior to the 2020 deadline.
