The Commission discussed online streaming of the monthly Public Meeting and directed staff to determine how many users from the public are accessing the Commission Agendas and Meeting Minutes on TransAqua's website and provide a cost estimate for this initiative.

5. Submissions by Commissioners

5.1 Commissioner Dingman – Riverview Municipal Plan

Commissioner Dingman informed the Commission that the Town of Riverview held a municipal plan review session that she attended. The Town of Riverview is proposing gentle density where existing single home lots can add up to 3 additional units (carriage house, to be serviced using one sewer lateral extending form the main home resulting in one sewer charge rather than 4. The municipalities all applied for the federal housing accelerator fund which requires 4 units as part of the criteria. There is concern that adding more users to the sewer system without the adequate cost recovery of additional processing costs could result in increased rates.

The Commission directed that a letter to the municipalities and Regional Service Commission be drafted regarding this issue.
