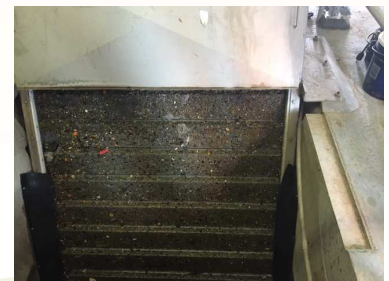
Upgrade and Modernization Project Update

The WWTF Upgrade and Modernization Project is progressing. The 4th secondary clarifier tank is under construction with the centre well being constructed. The sludge handling building addition to the dewatering building foundation is being poured. Construction will continue throughout the winter months. These two additions are currently on schedule. Do you know what happens when food is disposed of down your kitchen sink? Pipes can get blocked resulting in expensive maintenance or repairs. It is best to use a strainer over the drain in your sink, tub and shower and place all food scraps into your compost bin. TransAqua just commissioned its new fine screens that remove larger material from the wastewater. This helps to reduce the amount of solids entering the Petitcodiac River. Organic waste (mainly food) reduces the amount of oxygen in the wastewater that will result in higher GHG's and electricity bills for TransAqua (ultimately the ratepayer) to pump more oxygen into the bioreactor to keep the bugs happy, healthy and hungry.



2018 Compost Program Update!

At the end of September, TransAqua reintroduced 7,040 tonnes of compost back into the Greater Moncton Community for ratepayers gardening and landscaping projects. We are pleased to provide compost as part of our commitment to the community towards environmental sustainability.
